Since 1976, the Brantford Food Bank has provided support to individuals and families in need of food within our community. Today, as part of Community Resource Service, the Brantford Food Bank offers assistance through the delivery of two types of services. The Emergency Food Provision program is short-term help that provides a 2-3 day supply of food for those in immediate need. Longer-term solutions are offered through the Brantford Food Banks Co-operative program. This program offers a grocery supplement to assist low-income families by stretching their monthly income in exchange for volunteer hours and a small membership fee.
